



Application for a major variation to a medicinal cannabis licence under the *Narcotic Drugs Act 1967* – changes affecting layout of a premises, facility, security measures or activities

Screening Questions

1. Does the application relate to a medicinal cannabis licence issued by the Office of Drug Control (ODC) under the *Narcotic Drugs Act 1967* (the Narcotic Drugs Act)?
 - o Yes- proceed to Q.2.
 - o No- variations cannot be sought until a licence has been granted under the Narcotic Drugs Act.
2. Does the proposed variation relate to changes affecting the layout of a premises, facility, security measures or activities requiring updates to the site plan, floorplans or authorised activities?
 - o Yes- proceed with this application form.
 - o No- a different application form is required for any other variation topic, please see the ODC website.

Important information

This is an application to the Secretary of the Department of Health made under section 10N of the Narcotic Drugs Act to vary a medicinal cannabis licence under that Act relating to changes affecting the premises or security.

Irrespective of the person(s) completing this licence variation application form, the licence holder is accountable for the accuracy of the information entered and submitted as part of the application, including any supporting documents.

The application may be withdrawn at any time before a decision has been made, but the application fee is not refundable. If you decide to withdraw your application, then an email to this effect should be sent to MCS.application@health.gov.au.

Implementation of variations

Variations sought through this application must not be implemented by the licence holder until a decision approving the application, when made by the delegate, is notified in writing by the ODC. It should be noted that the lodgment of an application to vary a licence does not constitute approval to commence or continue activities that would be unauthorised under an existing licence. Conducting authorised activities where facilities or security arrangements have not been approved may be a breach of the licence and unlawful.

Privacy

The ODC collects a variety of personal information in the course of performing its function. Personal information is defined in the *Privacy Act 1988* (Privacy Act). Your personal information is protected by law under the Privacy Act, which contains the Australian Privacy Principles. The ODC is part of the Australian Government Department of Health. The ODC may validate any information provided with this application with Commonwealth, State and Territory law enforcement authorities, and, State and Territory regulatory, planning and/or infrastructure authorities.
