**Licensed premises and authorised activities**

The licensed premises and the activities authorised to be undertaken at the premises are detailed at Schedule 3.1.

**Ancillary activities**

The following activities are authorised to be undertaken at all premises included in schedules below:

- a) packaging, transport, storage, possession, and control of cannabis plants or a cannabis drug;
- b) the taking of samples from cannabis plants or a cannabis drug and the testing of such samples;
- c) the disposal or destruction of cannabis plants or cannabis drugs;
- d) supply of cannabis plants, cannabis or cannabis resin in accordance with the conditions of this licence;
- e) supply of a cannabis drug in accordance with the conditions of this licence.

The *Narcotic Drugs Act 1967* provides that a person who is authorised by a licence to engage in activities, and breaches a condition of the licence (other than a prescribed condition), may commit an offence or be liable to a civil penalty. Additional authorised person for a particular site or particular activity may be specified where relevant in the schedules below.

### Licence conditions

This medicinal cannabis licence is subject to:

1. Conditions set out in legislation (refer to Schedule 1); and
2. Conditions imposed by the Secretary:
  - a. in relation to the licence generally (refer to Schedule 2); and
  - b. in relation to particular licensed premises (refer to Schedule 3.1)

## Schedule 1 – Statutory Conditions

This medicinal cannabis licence is subject to the following conditions set out in legislation:

3. The conditions set out in sections 10E to 10K of the *Narcotic Drugs Act 1967*; and
4. The conditions set out in sections 17 to 20 of the *Narcotic Drugs Regulations 2016*.

## Schedule 2 – Conditions imposed by the Secretary on the licence generally

This medicinal cannabis licence is subject to the following imposed conditions:

5. For cannabis plants (including seeds and cuttings) that are cultivated in accordance with a medicinal cannabis permit for this licence, the licence holder may only:
  - transfer the cannabis plants between different premises;
  - supply the cannabis plants to other persons;as specified by that permit.
6. For cannabis or cannabis resin (including dried leaves, flowers, cannabis resin) that is produced in accordance with a medicinal cannabis permit for this licence, the licence holder may only:
  - transfer the cannabis or cannabis resin between different premises;
  - supply the cannabis or cannabis resin to other persons;as specified in that permit.
7. For a cannabis drug that is manufactured in accordance with a medicinal cannabis permit for this licence, the licence holder may only supply the cannabis drug to other persons as specified in that permit.
8. If the licence holder is authorised to manufacture a cannabis drug in accordance with a permit that is in force, the licence holder must ensure that they obtain and hold starting material in accordance with the quantities and limits specified on that permit (if any quantities and limits are specified).
9. The licence holder is being precluded from undertaking activities involving tissue culture, must keep records of the following:
  - a) the number of cannabis plants with roots that have been cultivated from tissue culture which were at any time in the possession of the licence holder;
  - b) the persons to which any such cannabis plants have been supplied, and the quantities thereof;
  - a) estimate, from week to week, of how many cannabis plants could be cultivated from the licence holder's current stock of tissue culture.
10. The licence holder must take reasonable steps to ensure that each licensed premises is maintained consistently with the floor plans and site plans included in this licence.

## Schedule 3.1 – Licensed premises

### Activities authorised at these premises

- Cultivation of cannabis plants for the purpose of producing cannabis or cannabis resin for medicinal or scientific purposes (and obtaining of cannabis plants for the purpose of such cultivation);
- Production of cannabis or cannabis resin for medicinal or scientific purposes.
- Manufacture of a cannabis drug for one or more permitted supplies.

The below conditions provide that the above activities can only be undertaken at the areas specified in the conditions imposed below and on the approved floor plan (see Attachment A) at the premises as per the approved site plan (see Attachment B).

Note: section 10G of the Act provides that it is a condition of the licence that the above activities be undertaken in accordance with a medicinal cannabis permit.

### Further conditions imposed by the Secretary relevant to licensed premises 1

The following further conditions are imposed on the licence in relation to licensed premises 1 only:

11. Cultivation of cannabis plants >1% tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) content can only occur in the following areas: **clone room, mother room, polytunnel A, polytunnel B, polytunnel C**
12. The maximum cultivation area that can be used for cultivation of cannabis plants >1% THC is: **600m<sup>2</sup>**
13. The maximum storage capacity of vaults/safes that are used to store cannabis, cannabis resins or manufactured cannabis drugs: **64m<sup>3</sup>**
14. The maximum storage capacity of areas that are used for cannabis waste: **8m<sup>3</sup>**

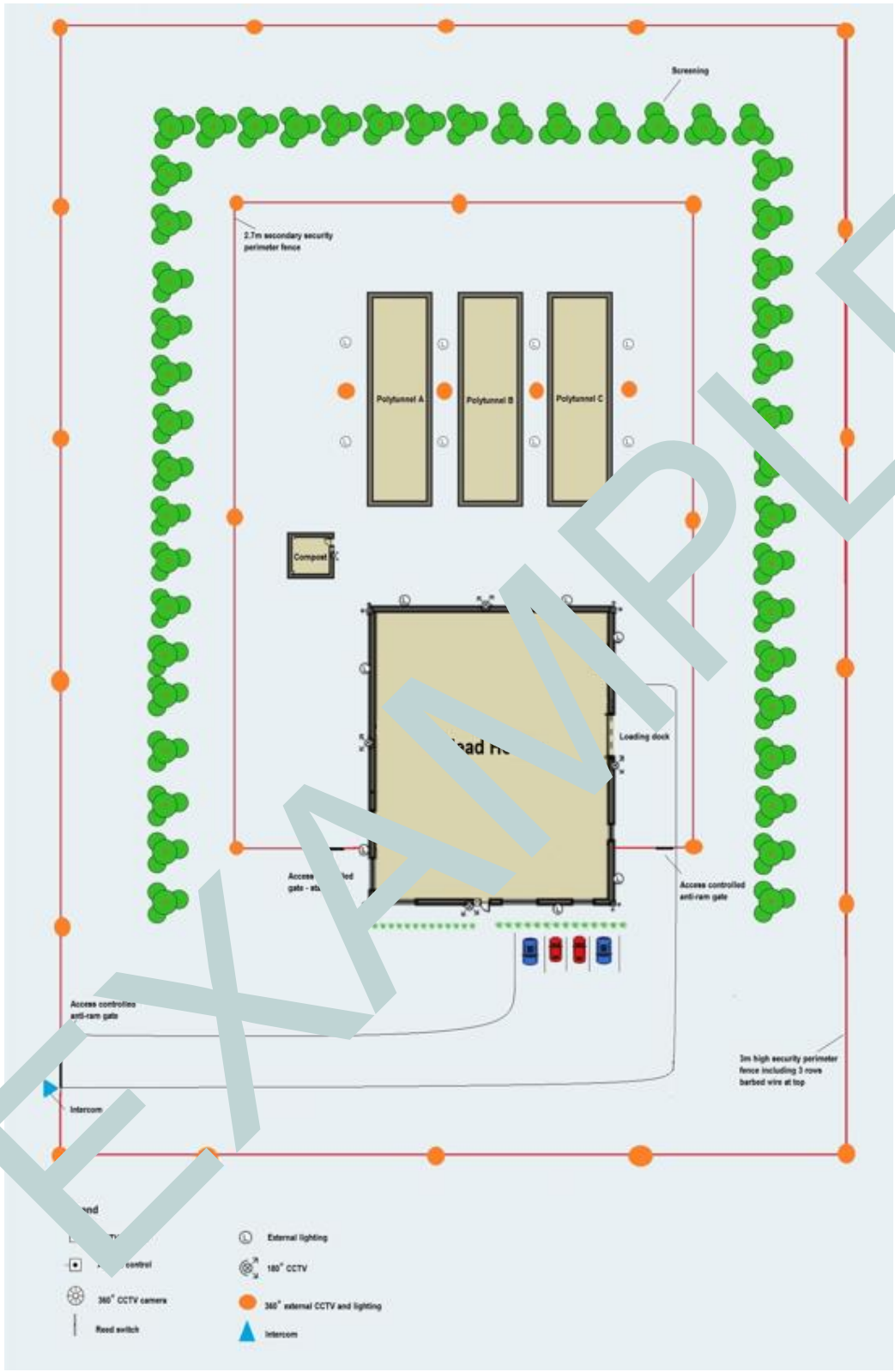
