### Application for cannabis licence

#### Important notice

Complete this licence module if it is applicable to your application. The completed module must be attached and submitted along with all other parts in order to form a complete application.

#### Information required

This module requests information relating to the type of licence and subsequent range of authorised activities for which approval is sought.

##### Legend:

Tetrahydrocannabinol = THC

Tetrahydrocannabinolic acid = THCA

Percent weight/weight = w/w%

**4.1 Psychoactive content**

Importantly, even when the cannabis leaves a licenced site, the cannabis remains under the control of the licence holder. For example, when a sample is sent to a laboratory for testing or during transportation by a contracted specialist.
